IN MEMORY OF BUDDY COOK

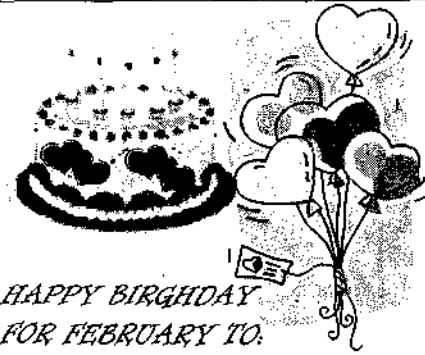
